

Our new *Shabbat* and Festival prayer book, *Siddur Lev Shalem*, provides explanations, enrichment, and transliterations to enhance our prayer experience. *Siddur Lev Shalem* (meaning “full, content heart”) includes both the traditional *Shabbat* and festival prayers and those written by modern poets and writers.

The *siddur* draws from more than 500 different sources – with writings from contemporary authors – and includes ancient blessings that date back to the first millennium in the land of Israel, as well as traditions from the full array of Jewish cultures – North African, Italian, Sephardic, Middle Eastern, Ashkenazi – across the range of Jewish history from ancient times to the contemporary.

There are many features to explore in this new *siddur* including a beautiful, prayerful translation that faithfully renders the Hebrew. We hope to become familiar with the *Siddur* over time and enjoy both familiar and new expressions and patterns in our prayer.
